

## AAHPM's College of Palliative Care 2008 Research Scholars Program Awards

In May 2008 the CPC awarded funding to 12 of 25 applicants of the CPC Research Scholars Program. This program will fund 6 physicians and 6 nurses to participate in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Retreat and Research Symposium of the National Palliative Care Research Center and the American Cancer Society with sponsorship from AAHPM's College of Palliative Care and will be held September 16 - 18, 2008 in Snoqualmie, Washington.

The goal of the Retreat and Research Symposium is to advance the scientific endeavors of those who are or will become independent investigators actively involved in palliative care research. After the pilot year, evaluations will be conducted to determine the success of the program and the commitment of funds for future years.
